of the Governor of the State of Illinois, have this day nominated, constituted, and appointed, and  
by these presents do nominate, constitute and appoint, my friend *Julius Regnier*

*of Morgan* of ~~Sangamon~~ county, and State of Illinois, my true and lawful Attorney, for

me, and in my name to ask, demand and receive, of the Pay-Master, who is or may be appointed

to pay off the troops on said expedition, my wages or compensation for the same, for me and in

my name; to sign such pay rolls or receipts as may be necessary to effectuate the object of the

authority, as fully and to the same extent as I myself might do, were I personally present at

the doing of the same. And I hereby ratify and confirm whatsoever my said attorney may do

touching the premises, by virtue of these presents. In testimony whereof, I have this *8* day of *Aug*
