

Sec. 1. Be it enacted by the people of the State of
Ohio in representation in the General Assembly,
That so much of the State Road, leading from Jacksonsville
in Morgan County, to Quincy in Adams County
(established by an act entitled "An act to locate
a State Road from Jacksonsville in Morgan County
to Quincy in Adams County, and for other purposes,
approved February 25th 1833;") as lies within
Schuyler County, be and the same is hereby
vacated.

Sec. 2. Be it further enacted, that John Taylor
Senr. Benjamin Kinderick, and Harry Foster of
the County of Schuyler, be and they are hereby
appointed commissioners to view, mark and
locate a State Road from a point on the West
Bank of Meirion river, opposite Macedonia,
thence the nearest and best route, through
Mount Sterling to the Western Boundary
line of Schuyler County in the direction of

Running, doing as little injury to private
property, as the public convenience will permit.
Sec 2^d. Said Commissioners or a majority of
them shall meet at Mount Sterling on the
first Monday in May next, or within one
month thereafter, and after being duly sworn
by some Justice of the peace, faithfully to perform
the duties required of them by this act, shall proceed
to locate said road accordingly, said road shall be
marked in the prairie, by suitable stakes, well
set in the earth, and in the timbered land,
by hicks and blazes upon the trees. They shall
make a return of the location thereof, to the
County Commissioners Court of Shelby County,
particularly noting all the principal places
upon and near said road. Said Commissioners
shall receive for their services, one dollar and
fifty cents each per day, for all the time
necessarily employed in said work, together with
a reasonable compensation for one hand, as a
marker, which sum shall be paid by the
County of Shelby.

County of Schuylker. Said road shall
in all respects be deemed a public highway
and shall be opened and kept in repair
as other State roads are.
