

Section 1

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois represented in the General Assembly, that the County Commissioners Court of any of the Counties on the military tract when they shall appoint a Commissioner to transcribe certain records, as provided by an Act, entitled "An Act to provide for transcribing certain Records therein named" Approved February 12th A.D. 1835. are hereby authorized and empowered to allow said Commissioner, such reasonable compensation, in addition to the compensation authorized, by the above recited Act, not exceeding seventy five cents, for each Deed on title paper so transcribed, or they may deem proper.
