AN ACT to repeal "an act to improve the breed of Cattle."

SEC. 1. *Be it enacted by the people of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly,* That the "act to improve the breed of cattle," approved 16th January 1836, be, and the same is hereby repealed.

AN ACT making the clerks of the county Commissioners Courts and county treasurers, elective by the People.

In force 7th Feb. 1837.

SEC. 1. *Be it enacted by the people of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly,* That an election shall be held on the first Monday in August next, and on the first Monday in August in the year one thousand eight hundred and thirty-nine, and on the first Monday in August, in every fourth year thereafter in each county in this State, for a clerk of the county commissioners court and county treasurer. The clerks and treasurer so elected, shall continue in office for four years, and until their successors shall be elected and qualified to office; and previous to their entering upon the duties of their respective offices, shall enter into bonds as is now required by law. Said securities to be approved by the county commissioners courts.

SEC. 2. The election provided for in this act, shall be held at the same places and conducted in all respects as is now provided for by the law regulating elections in relation to the election of county commissioners; and vacancies shall be filled in the same manner, *Provided*, Said courts may appoint a clerk and treasurer pro tempore, whose time of service shall continue until a clerk or treas-
