

AN ACT to alter the name of William Lock,

In force 18th  
Feb. 1837

*Be it enacted by the people of the State of Illinois represented in the General Assembly, That William Lock, of the county of Morgan, shall hereafter be called and known by the name of William W. Hobbs, and by the name of William W. Hobbs shall sue and be sued, plead and be impleaded, defend and be defended, in all courts of law and equity, and in all other places; and by the name of William W. Hobbs make all contracts, do and perform all legal acts of whatsoever character, name or description: Provided, That nothing herein contained shall affect any contract heretofore entered into, or any other legal acts done and performed by the said William Lock.*

APPROVED 18th February, 1837.

AN ACT to change the name of Free Frank,

In force 19th  
Jan. 1837

**SEC. 1.** *Be it enacted by the people of the State of Illinois represented in the General Assembly, That the name of Free Frank, of the county of Pike and State of Illinois, be and is hereby changed to that of Frank McWorter, by which latter name he shall hereafter be called and known, and sue and be sued, plead and be impleaded, purchase and convey both real and personal property in said last mentioned name, and the children of said Free Frank shall hereafter take the name of their father, as changed and provided for by this act.*

AN ACT to amend an act entitled "an act for the appointment of No-  
taries Public," approved December 30th, 1828,In force 16th

**SEC. 1.** *Be it enacted by the people of the State of Illinois represented in the General Assembly, That it shall be the duty of the Governor, by and with the advice and consent of the Senate, to appoint in the town of Chicago, county of Cook, two additional notaries public, whose duties and term of service shall be the same as are now*
