

A bill for an act for the relief of the Clerk of  
the Circuit Court of Sangamon County—

Sec. 1 Be it enacted by the people of the State of  
Illinois represented in the General Assembly,  
that whenever the Clerk of the Circuit Court of  
Sangamon County shall make out a fee bill in  
due form of law, for services rendered by him or  
by his predecessor in office, as Clerk, in all cases  
in which the president and directors of the State  
Banks of Illinois were a party, so far as said services  
were rendered for said Bank, and for which it  
is, or would be liable, as such party, and shall  
transmit the same to the Auditor of Public Accounts,  
said Auditor shall issue his warrant upon the  
Treasury in favour of said Clerk for such amount  
as may be so shown to be due him—

Sec. 2 Said Clerk, in making out said fee bill  
shall be liable to the same penalties and forfeitures  
for any violation of the present law regulating fees  
as he would be in any other case—
