

Sec 1.

Be it enacted by the people of the State of Illinois, represented in the general Assembly, that so much of the fourth section of an act entitled "An act to establish the counties of Menard, Logan and Hamilton" approved the fifteenth day of February one thousand eight hundred and thirty three, as provides for a change of the boundary line of Menard County, and consequence of the location of the County seat thereof, be, and the same is hereby repealed - and that said boundary line of the said County of Menard, on the East side of the Sangamon River, shall remain permanent as is provided in the first section of the act above ~~mentioned~~

Sec 2.

That all that portion of Sangamon County lying West of the Sangamon River, and North of the line dividing sections Twenty four and Twenty five in Township six and north, Range seven West, shall be attached to, and form a part of Menard County.

Sec 3.

That the collector of Menard County, shall collect of the citizens on the East side of the Sangamon River, who are lawfully attached to Menard County, the State and County Tax due from them for the year one thousand eight hundred and thirty nine, as assessed by the assessor of said County of Menard in said year,

and that the said collector, shall on
or before the first day of June one
thousand eight hundred and forty one,
pay over the same, and in the same
manner, as he is required to do in the
collection of Taxes from other citizens
of said County.

Sec 4. This act to be in force
from and after its passage.
