On said route there is now a three horse coach for the accommodation of passengers running on said route twice a week

Said route would supersede route No. 31 or the route from New Vineyard to Trison which is about the same distance of miles and the expense would not be increased to the P. O. department

The undersigned would therefore respectfully request that a mail route be established and that the mail be carried through from ~~said~~ Farmington to Kingfield twice a week leaving Farmington Tuesdays and Saturdays immediately after the arrival of the Hallowell mail and carried through the same day and returning leave Kingfield Wednesdays and Mondays at 1 o'clock A. M. and that a Post Office be established at Strong to be denominated East Strong P. O. And in duty bound will ever pray
