Williams County Ohio respectfully represent that
the public necessity requires, that your Honorable
body establish a Mail Route, commencing at Lima
Pa. and extending by way of Lexington to Jackson, Steu-
ben, and Hamilton of aforesaid State. Thence to Saint
Joseph, Williams Centre, Washington, and Brumsburgh,
to Defiance Ohio: Intersecting the Southern Mail from
Cincinnati by way of Miami Canal: which opens a di-
rect communication to Chicago Illinois and the western
part of the United States. And by so doing your Petitioners
will ever pray.
