Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the United States of America, in Congress assembled: That hereafter the legal holder of any land warrant issued under the provision of the ninth section of the act to which this an amendment, may locate the same at any land office of the United States, in one body, or in parcels, ^{and subject to the present limitation in relation to the purchase of small quantities of land} conformity to the legal subdivisions of the public lands, ^{and from any} of the public lands, within the land district of such office, then subject to private entry, or to which such warrant holder may, at the time of location, have a legal right of pre-emption - Provided, that the whole right of location under any one warrant, shall be exhausted at one time -
