A BILL

For the relief of the securities of Elijah J. Weed, late quartermaster of marines, deceased.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Repre-
- 2 sentatives of the United States of America in Congress
- 3 assembled, That the accounting officers of the Treasury
- 4 Department be, and they are hereby, authorized to settle
- 5 the accounts of Major Elijah J. Weed, late quartermaster
- 6 of marines, deceased, on equitable principles: Provided,
- The allowances made under this act shall not exceed the
- 8 balance now claimed by the government from his securi-
- 9 ties: And provided further, That no allowances shall be
- 10 made for articles procured for said officer's office without
- 11 warrant of law, or established usage of the department to
- 12 which he belonged.
