

To the Honorable the Senate and House
of Representatives of the United States of
America in Congress assembled.

The undersigned inhabitants of the State
of Illinois would respectfully represent that a
mail route is much needed, and would be of
essential service to your petitioners and the
public in general. Commencing at the
La Salle Post Office, in the Town of Peru
in the State of Illinois, running by Boy Grove
and Ovid Post Office, Dewey's Mills in Intit
Grove. La Fayette Grove. Kelley's Mills, in White
Oak Grove, Stillman and Fishwauna and
terminate at Rockford in the State of Illinois.
The importance of connecting the two places,
Peru, and Rockford by a mail route is
visible to all acquainted with the country;
besides the advantage to be derived to the
aforementioned places along the route by the
receipt of a regular mail are of sufficient
importance to require it.

Your petitioners would therefore request
the passage of an act establishing a mail
route from La Salle Post Office aforesaid
passing through and by the aforementioned
places and terminating at Rockford aforesaid,
and authorizing the carrying of a
tri weekly mail in two horse post coaches along
said route, And as in duty bound will ever
obey.
