And that it would be for the interest of all concerned if the said mail should be carried once a week upon the present route & once a week via East Delavan, Delavan, Weed's Corners, Richmond & Utters Corners, to Whitewater. & they would recommend that and petition your Hon. Bodies to Establish & Alter said Routes as above Dated at Elkhorn Jan 6th 1848
