Read twice, and referred to the Committee on Commerce.

AN ACT

To change the location of certain light-houses and buoys.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Repre-*
2 *sentatives of the United States of America in Congress*
3 *assembled,* That the Secretary of the Treasury is hereby
4 authorized and directed to change the location of the fol-
5 lowing named light-houses, directed to be built by the act
6 of the last session, to wit: From Teller's point on the
7 Hudson river to Tarrytown point on said river; from
8 Galveston Island to Bolivar point; from Long island, in
9 Savannah river, to the knob connected with Cockspur
10 island in the said river; and that the Secretary of the
11 Treasury be authorized to substitute a dumb beacon
12 instead of a light-house, if he shall deem it best for the
13 public interest, from Santee river to the outer point of
14 Bull's island, at the entrance of Bull's bay; and that the

15 buoy authorized by the said act, to be placed at the en-
 16 trance of Bull's bay, shall be placed at such point as the
 17 collector of the port of Charleston, South Carolina, shall
 18 direct.
