Mr. HUNT, from the Committee on Commerce, reported the following bill:

A BILL

For the improvement of certain harbors in the Territory of Wisconsin.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the United States of America in Congress assembled, That the following sums of money be, and the same are hereby, appropriated, out of any moneys in the treasury not otherwise appropriated, viz:

For the improvement of the harbor at Southport, on Lake Michigan, four thousand dollars;

For the improvement of the harbor at Racine, on Lake Michigan, four thousand dollars;

- 10 For the improvement of the harbor, at Sheboygan,
- 11 on Lake Michigan, four thousand dollars; which sums
- 12 shall be expended under the direction of the Secretary of
