A BILL

For the relief of the legal representatives of William D. Cheever, deceased.

1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Repre-2 sentatives of the United States of America in Congress 3 assembled, That the Secretary of the Treasury be, and 4 he hereby is, directed to pay to the legal representatives 5 of William D. Cheever, deceased, twenty-one thousand 6 two hundred and thirty-one dollars and eighteen cents, 7 out of any money in the treasury not otherwise appro-8 priated, being the amount of his loss on treasury notes 9 while engaged in supplying the army of the United States, 10 under a contract with the Secretary of War, during the 11 years eighteen hundred and fourteen and eighteen hundred 15 and fifteen, and reported by the Secretary of the Treasury 13 to be due.
