Mr. NELSON, from the Committee of Claims, reported the following bill:

A BILL

For the relief of Andrew A. Jones, an inspector of the customs of the port of New York.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Repre-*
2 *sentatives of the United States of America in Congress*
3 *assembled,* That the Secretary of the Treasury be, and he
4 is hereby, authorized and empowered to pay to Andrew
5 A. Jones, an inspector of the customs for the port and
6 district of New York, the sum of six hundred and one
7 dollars and fifty-seven cents, for extra services done and
8 performed by him from the third day of July, eighteen
9 hundred and forty-four, to the thirty-first day of December,
10 in the year eighteen hundred and forty-five, in the custom-
11 house of said port.
