ABILL

For the relief of Andrew A. Jones, an inspector of the customs of the port of New York.

- Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Repre-

- 3 assembled, That the Secretary of the Treasury be, and he
- 4 is hereby, authorized and empowered to pay to Andrew
- 5 A. Jones, an inspector of the customs for the port and
- 6 district of New York, the sum of six hundred and one
- 7 dollars and fifty-seven cents, for extra services done and
- 8 performed by him from the third day of July, eighteen
- 9 hundred and forty-four, to the thirty-first day of December,
- in the year eighteen hundred and forty-five, in the custom-
- 11 house of said port.
