Mr. JOHNSON, of Louisiana, from the Committee on Private Land Claims, reported the following bill: which was read, and passed to a second reading.

A BILL

For the relief of Nathaniel Hoggatt.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Repre-*
2 *sentatives of the United States of America in Congress*
3 *assembled,* That the entries heretofore made of lands in
4 sections thirty-two, thirty-six, thirty-eight, thirty-nine, forty,
5 forty-four, forty-five, forty-six, forty-seven, forty-nine, fifty,
6 and fifty-one, in township sixteen north, of range fourteen
7 east, in the district north of Red river, Louisiana, and
8 for which patents have been issued in favor of Nathaniel
9 Hoggatt, be, and the same are hereby, legalized and con-
10 firmed.
