A BILL

For the relief of Nathaniel Hoggatt.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Repre-
- 2 sentatives of the United States of America in Congress
- 3 assembled, That the entries heretofore made of lands in
- 4 sections thirty-two, thirty-six, thirty-eight, thirty-nine, forty,
- 5 forty-four, forty-five, forty-six, forty-seven, forty-nine, fifty,
- 6 and fifty-one, in township sixteen north, of range fourteen
- 7 east, in the district north of Red river, Louisiana, and
- 8 for which patents have been issued in favor of Nathaniel
- 9 Hoggatt, be, and the same are hereby, legalized and con-
- 10 firmed.
