A BILL

For the relief of William J. Price.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Repre-2 sentatives of the United States of America in Congress 3 assembled, That William J. Price be, and he is hereby, confirmed in his title to a certain tract of land situate in 4 5 the county of Jackson, State of Alabama, on the waters of Jones's creek, known as William Jones's reservation. 6 it being the place first settled by William Jones, and, after 7 his death, transferred by his widow and heirs-at-law to 8 9 said William J. Price: Provided, That this confirmation
- 10 shall only operate as a relinquishment on the part of the
- 11 United States, and shall not affect the rights of any minor
- 12 heir or heirs, or of third persons.
