Mr. W. R. W. COBB, from the Committee on Public Lands,
reported the following bill:

A BILL

For the relief of William J. Price.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Repre-*
2 *sentatives of the United States of America in Congress*
3 *assembled, That* William J. Price be, and he is hereby,
4 confirmed in his title to a certain tract of land situate in
5 the county of Jackson, State of Alabama, on the waters
6 of Jones's creek, known as William Jones's reservation,
7 it being the place first settled by William Jones, and, after
8 his death, transferred by his widow and heirs-at-law to
9 said William J. Price: *Provided, That* this confirmation
10 shall only operate as a relinquishment on the part of the
11 United States, and shall not affect the rights of any minor
12 heir or heirs, or of third persons.
