Mr. FULTON, from the Committee on Invalid Pensions, reported the following bill:

A BILL

For the relief of Jonathan Naif.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Repre-*
2 *sentatives of the United States of America in Congress*
3 *assembled,* That the Secretary of War be, and he hereby
4 is, directed to place the name of Jonathan Naif on the roll
5 of invalid pensioners, at the rate of eight dollars per
6 month, from the first day of January, eighteen hundred
7 and forty-nine, and to continue during his natural life.
