A BILL

For the relief of Captain Cassius M. Clay.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Repre-
- 2 sentatives of the United States of America in Congress
- 3 assembled, That the Secretary of the Treasury be, and he
- 4 is hereby, directed to pay to Captain Cassius M. Clay,
- 5 out of any moneys in the treasury not otherwise appropri-
- 6 ated, the sum of five hundred and thirty-three dollars and
- 7 twenty cents, it being the amount of a judgment obtained
- 8 in a court in Kentucky against, and paid by, said Clay, for
- 9 an act performed by him in obedience to the lawful com-
- 10 mand of his superior officer.
