

**BE IT ENACTED** by the Senate and House of Representa-  
tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

**THAT** the proper accounting officers of the Treasury be,  
and they are hereby, authorized and required to audit  
and settle the accounts of Abraham Edwards, register of  
the land office at Kalamazoo, Michigan, upon prin-  
ciples of equity and justice; and that whatever sum  
or sums of money, if any, be found due said Edwards,  
shall be paid out of any money in the treasury not  
otherwise appropriated.
