Congress of the United States

Resolved By the Senate and House of Representatives of the United States of America in
CONGRESS ASSEMBLED,

That the Secretary of the Navy, be instructed to purchase, and pay out of the contingent fund of his department, for a sufficient number of copies of Mecklin and Winder's General Navy Register and Laws, to supply one copy to each commissioned officer now in the Naval Service; and that the work be distributed to such officers; Provided, however, That the cost shall not exceed three dollars per copy.
