On this 6 day of August one thousand eight hundred and fifty-5 personally appeared before me A. Justice of the Peace within and for the County and State aforesaid Charles R. Price aged 57 years, a resident of the County of Sangamon and State of Illinois who being duly sworn according to law, declares that he is the identical Charles R. Price who was a Private in the company commanded by captain Abraham Lincoln in the 4 regiment of Ill. Mounted Vols commanded by colonel Samuel M. Thompson in the war with the Indians commonly called or known as the Black Hawk War that her said husband enlisted Vol. in Sangamon Co. Ill. on or about the 21 day of April A. D. 1833 for the term of 30 days and was in actual service in said war for fourteen days, and was honorably discharged at H. Wittman ottawa on or near the last day of May A. D. 1833 She further states that she was married to the said _____ in _____ on the _____ day of _____ A. D. 18_____ by one _____ and that her name before her said marriage was _____ that her said husband died at _____ on the _____ day of _____ A. D. 18_____ and that she is now a widow.

He further declares that he has heretofore made application for bounty land under the Act of September 28th 1850 on March 22 1850 and received a Land Warrant No 10,304 for 4.0 acres, which he has since legally disposed of and can not be returned. He makes this declaration for the purpose of obtaining the additional bounty land to which he may be entitled under the Act approved March 3d, 1855. He also declares that he has never applied for nor received under this or any other act of Congress, any bounty land warrant except the one above mentioned. That he hereby appoints **E. Wright and Wm. J. Conkling**, or either of them his true and lawful Attorney, with power of substitution to prosecute this his claim for bounty land; to receive the certificate or warrant when issued, and to do all other acts necessary and proper in the premises.
